When:

Spring equinox- 21 Sept- approx. Floriade

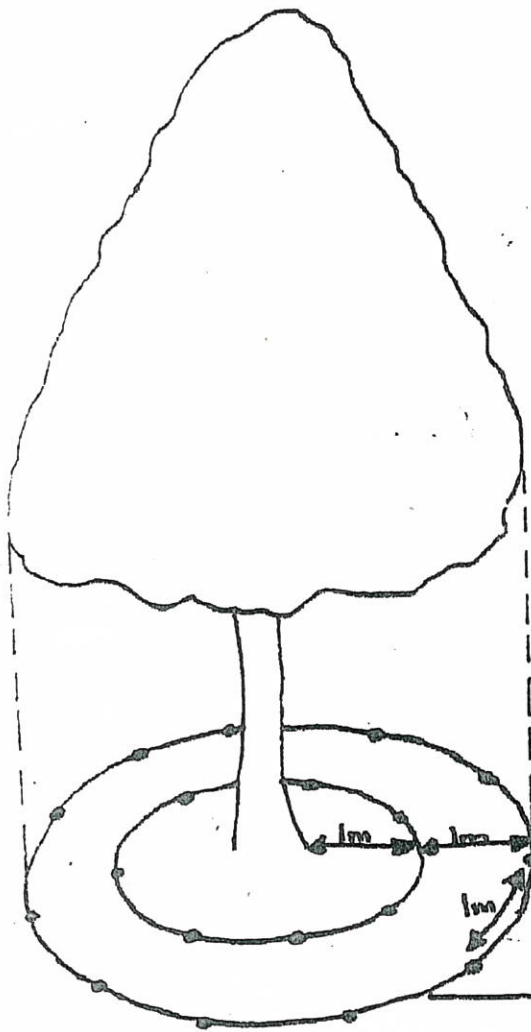
- To assist with breaking winter dormancy and to give energy boost for spring growth

Summer solstice- 21 Dec- approx. Christmas

- For bark development (secondary thickening) and expansion of girth, helps harden off soft spring growth

Autumn equinox- 21 March- approx. Easter

- For carbohydrate storage in bark, like an energy source while dormant in winter
- Provides food for root development and growth end July/ early August → September



How:

Make holes (•) with stake or similar, 20cm (8") deep, 1m apart in concentric rings 1m apart, starting 1m from trunk (0.5m for young trees less than 5yrs old). If older, 1m from trunk until reaching drip line.

Add 1tsp Healthy Earth general purpose fertiliser per hole.

Water in thoroughly.

Drip Line

Holes 1m apart, 20cm (8") deep.

Concentric rings 1m apart.
Start 1m from trunk →
drip line
